PAVEMENT PRESERVATION PROGRAM

The City of Richland Public Works Department is preparing to begin the annual Pavement Preservation Program. Citizens who will be directly impacted by upcoming construction will be receiving a postcard in the coming weeks.

The Pavement Preservation Program includes applications such as microsurfacing, slurry seal, overlay and other types of treatments. This year, efforts will focus on North Richland.

Preparatory project work, including crack sealing, has already started with the main pavement preservation work scheduled for this summer.

used by anyone under the age of sixteen (16). It is legal to discharge fireworks during the following dates and times:

June 29 to July 3	9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.
July 4	9:00 a.m. to Midnight
July 5	9:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

SUMMER AIR CONDITIONER PREP:

- Service your air conditioner or heat pump on a regular basis.
- Clean or change filters monthly or as recommended by the filter manufacturer.
- Remove leaves and other debris that may be obstructing the outdoor unit.
- Clean and check the air vents and remove obstructions

USE APPLIANCES WISELY:

- Run your dishwasher only for full loads.
- Dry laundry on a clothesline outside.
 When you use the clothes dryer, use the moisture sensor setting to avoid overdrying clothes.
